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## NEWBORN KITS

Help mothers in developing countries celebrate the birth of their child, and provide needed items to welcome their baby into the world. Healthcare workers who distribute these kits also use them to encourage women to seek prenatal care, offering them as gifts if a mother visits a clinic before delivery, or chooses to deliver her baby at a healthcare facility. Prenatal visits provide opportunities to monitor the health of the mother and developing child and to share information about nutrition, immunizations, and how to care for a newborn. We will be collecting items for these kits over next few weeks and they will be delivered to the ELCA Synod Assembly following a blessing from Pastor Jeff on April 29th. Please visit the Mission Table where you can purchase items of your choosing for the kits, or make a donation.

If you would like to assemble your own kit, the items for inclusion are: 1 bath towel (42 x 52), 1 wash cloth, 1 bath size bar of Ivory soap, 1 newborn stocking hat, 1 receiving blanket (30 x 30), 2 cloth diapers, 2 diaper pins. Assembly instructions are available at the Mission Table. Our goal this year is 50 kits.

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## St. Martin’s 6th Annual Plant Sale – May 4th and 5th

St. Martin’s Plant Sale will be held on Friday, May 4th and Saturday, May 5th (Trout Days)

from 9 AM - noon each day. For you gardeners out there or anyone wanting to help out, start thinking about plants in your garden that will need dividing or thinning, house plants that need downsizing, or any plants that you just don't have room for anymore. Now's the time to take cuttings from house plants or start plants (house plants, annuals, perennials, even fruits and vegetables) from seed. Well-watered plant donations can be accepted a few days ahead of the sale – tables near the Prayer Garden will be available for this purpose. There will also be plastic pots available in the same location.



In addition to plant donations the Prayer Garden Team is asking that you tag each donation with the name of the plant and the color of its bloom (if applicable). Flat cardboard boxes for packaging up sold plants would also be appreciated. We will also need assistance setting-up and taking-down displays on both days of the sale and help with sales on either/both days. Sign-up sheets for donations and assistance can be found near the 2018 Plant Sale display in the Narthex of the church.

Get your green thumbs on and help us make this another successful plant sale! Proceeds will be divided between costs to maintain our beautiful Prayer Garden and a mission emphasis yet to be chosen.
