If you are looking for activities for your children to do this coming summer, there is one in particular that is fun-filled, Christ-centered, and unforgettable! Sugar Creek Bible Camp is an ELCA affiliated church camp in the valleys along the Mississippi River, just outside of Ferryville, WI. There are programming opportunities ranging from elementary aged up through graduating high schoolers. Some programs are more specialized, such as Junior Wranglers Horse Camp and JAM Music Camp, and there are programs divided up into age groups with various activities all around camp. This beautiful place has features such as horse stables, creeks and ponds to do bible study around, and an all-around place where people of all ages are welcome.
