St. Martin's Legacy Endowment Fund

On January 25, 2015 St. Martin's Congregation adopted a permanent resolution for the creation and governance of St. Martin's Lutheran Church Legacy Endowment Fund (hereafter referred to as the Fund). I am happy to announce The Legacy Endowment Fund Board of St. Martin's has been formed, and effective December 1st has its first \$100 in the Fund. The Board held a meeting on November 16, 2015 and elected Van Valaskey Chairperson, Hilary Kirikov Secretary, Lois Weiland Treasurer, Tom Johnson Marketing Director and yours truly, James Hartung, Congregation Liaison.

As Congregational Liaison I would like to give you a quick overview of the St. Martin's Legacy Endowment Fund. You will also hear a Temple Talk December 13 with more details. The purpose of this fund is to enhance the mission of St. Martin's Lutheran Church apart from the general operation of the congregation. Gifts to this Endowment Fund ensure the continuation of the many ministries and missions of St. Martin's into the future. It is the intent that distributions from the Fund shall not be used for the annual operation budget of the Congregation.

Furnance / Water Heater Update

Last spring the council made a capitol appeal of the congregation to replace the church's seven aging furnaces, as well as the two water heaters. A generous member responded with a challenge to the congregation to raise \$10,000, at which point they would donate a matching \$10,000. You responded by donating \$12,520, which brought our grand total to \$22,520! Thank you all for your generosity!

Work was scheduled in September, for a time when neither the furnaces or air conditioning would be needed. Since the entire system would need to be shut down, it was felt that a time between heating and cooling seasons would work best. Modern Heating completed the work on the furnaces at a cost of \$12,925. Concurrently with the furnace work, the oldest of the two water heaters was replaced at a cost of \$1,140. The second water heater is scheduled to be replaced mid-December, at an estimated cost of \$1,150.

Upon completion of the project there will be a balance of \$7,305. When the capitol appeal was made, the council decided that any monies left over would be applied to future building improvement needs. Some possible projects include replacing the flashing around the sanctuary skylight, painting of the exterior beams and fascia, and painting the exteriors of the windows and doors.
