May 2016 Financial Snapshot for Saint Martin's Lutheran Church

Service Receipts: (the negative number below means we are behind budget, which is not good)

Budget YTD offering receipts = \$101.064.00 Year-to-date offering receipts = \$80.014.25 -\$.21.049.75

Total Income: (again, the negative number below is not good)

Budget YTD Income = \$132,644.00 Year-to-date Income = \$.97,418.07 -\$ 35,225.93

Expenses: (the negative number below is good - we are not spending as much as we budgeted for)

Budget YTD expenses = \$132,592.00 Year-to-date expenses = \$ 98,445.14 -\$.34,146.86

Our expenses through April are below our budgeted amount; however our service receipts are substantially below budget. Service receipts from our monthly/weekly offerings make up 90% of our income. While we are holding the line on expenses, we are having to dip into our cash reserves to make up the deficit. This is not a wise long term plan. Additionally, with summer approaching, giving tends to taper off, you may be planning your family vacations, but our bills do not take a vacation.

Above all, our giving to St. Martin's and to God should come from the heart and out of thankfulness for what He provides for us. As you pray about your giving plan to St. Martin's, please consider regular, automatic contributions, as it helps even out the peaks and valleys of cash flow.

Plant A Row ('PAR')

The 'PAR' garden has been tilled & prepared by Whitey Hillebrand, and Ralph Schulenberg has already planted potatoes, beets and onions as St Martin's begins their mission of donating the harvest to area food pantries to feed the hungry.

A donation box is on the table in the narthex for contributions towards the purchase of additional fruits, vegetables and other items for the garden. "Inch by inch, row by row, gonna make this garden grow."
