Pick up a copy of your own and begin reading. Then join our next discussion night:



The success of the sale is having your home baked holiday favorites available to sell.


Please drop your cookies off on Friday, Dec. 4th (fellowship kitchen) from 4:30pm-6pm or 8am on the morning before the sale starts.
